Psalm 1

Psalm 1 contrasts a person who aligns with God and one who aligns with the wicked. Discuss what Psalm 1:1-3 states about the person who aligns with God and what the result is of that person's actions.

Psalm 1:3 uses a metaphor of a tree bearing fruit. What does it mean to bear fruit? What are some examples of fruit that a person could bear?

Psalms 1:4-6 talks about the wicked, and that the path of the wicked leads to destruction. What are your thoughts on the destruction that verse 6 is referring to?

What are the sources that feed you messages throughout the week? It could be the news, radio, friends, co-workers, and etc... What messages seem to affect you the most?

How do you most naturally worship God? Is it through reading, music, prayer, taking a walk? Share what feels most natural for you.

Psalm 1:2 discusses meditating on God's word. As a group, choose a portion of Scripture to meditate on this week.
