Can you retell the story of Habakkuk Chapter 1 in your own words? (The chapter is divided in sections according to a conversation between Habakkuk and God: Vs 2-4, 5-11, 12-17)

Habakkuk Chapter 2

Read Habakkuk 2:2-4a and answer the following. What does God tell Habakkuk to do in 2:2-4a? What does God want Habakkuk to understand and do? Why do you think God wants this people to address based on Habakkuk 2:2-4a? What do we learn about the nature of God in this section? How is the Goodness of God seen in Justice?

Some people may believe the God of the Old Testament is different than the God of the New Testament. How does Hebrews 4:12-13, Luke 12:1-3 or Mark 4:21-23 relate to Habakkuk 2:2-4a? How is God the Same in the Old and New Testament? How do these passages impact you in your relationship with the Lord?

- What is Justification? Who is Just? Habakkuk 2:4b
- What does it mean to live by Faith? Habakkuk 2:4b
- What does Hebrews 11:1; Ephesians 2:8-9; and James 2:19 teach us Faith is and is not?
- Why did authors of the New Testament quote Habakkuk 2:4? What is the context surrounding their use in the New Testament? Romans 1:17; Galatians 3:11; Hebrews 10:38
