#2 Recovery Road (Hosea)

- Living in insecurity will lead to two things: #1 It will lead you where you do not belong, and #2 it will keep you from where you are called to be. Do you agree or disagree? Why or why not? What makes Hosea 14:1,2,4 so important.
- Why did the Lord choose a harlot as His example to represent Israel's relationship with the Lord?
- Even though Gomer is a harlot toward God, how does God demonstrate his love toward Gomer? Why is God's response so important?
- What does God say to allure us back to security in Him? Read Hosea 2:14-23 and pay attention to the "I Will" Statements by God. Why does God point us to these statements?
- The Bible encourages us to allow our thoughts to be captivated by Christ (2 Corinthians 10:5). Rather than act out of insecurity, what should you do to find security? What bible verses help you find identity and security in Christ? If you do not have a verse, look at the following verses and see if any of them speak to you. Philippians 4:19; Matthew 6:31-34; Romans 8:31-39; 2 Corinthians 5:17-21; 2 Corinthians 10:5.
- In times of Insecurity, how can you be used of God to love on people with a Hosea kind of love? How does Hosea love help others find security in uncertainty?
- Right now, some Americans are feeling insecure over politics. Rather than argue, this gives God's people a great place to offer genuine hope. What security does Daniel 2:21 and Proverbs 21:1 offer? How might the previous verses help us live out 1st Peter 2:13-17 or Romans 13:1-8?
