## CULTURAL COLLISION DANIEL 10-11

- Read 1 John 4:20 and in your own words describe what God desires? Why? How might someone see Daniel reflecting the attitude of 1 John 4:20 in Daniel 10:1-3 (it may be helpful to know Daniel is aware of the events of Ezra 4:1-5)? Do you, like Daniel, have a burden or concern for something big or small that reflects the attitude of 1 John 4:20? (as you think about an answer, please note the remaining questions should help you think through Christ centered actions)
- What does Daniel 10:13,20 teach us about the spiritual world? Why would God want to make Daniel aware of spiritual battles?
- What does Paul want believers to know in Ephesians 6:10-12 (especially verse 12)? Why is this important? How does Paul encourage believers to live in Ephesians 6:13-18? What are some ways Christians' apply Ephesians 6:10-18 well and what are some ways Christians fail to properly apply this passage?
- Why does God want to focus his people on Daniel 12:1-3? How might Daniel 12:1-3 provide us with a broader perspective? How should this passage encourage or challenge God's people?
