Hebrews 13:1-6

Read Hebrews 13:1-3. Share about a time when someone was hospitable or showed love unselfishly to you and how it affected you or share about a time when no one was hospitable or loving to you and how it affected you.

Discover how Nehemiah responded toward the situation of his countrymen in Neh. 1:3-5. What can we learn from this example on how to treat others in need?

Hebrews 13:4-5 provides a means to examine your heart to determine whether you are surrendered to God. Read the passage and discuss how the actions described in the passage could lead a person to selfish living rather than selfless living.

What part of loving others and being hospitable is easy and what part is hard for you?

Hebrews 13:5-6 states that God will never leave us, He is our helper, and we do not need to fear. Share with the group how you have experienced God in the way the passage describes.

Who are your people? Who do you felt drawn to love, and how can you show love to them this week?
