Hebrews 11-12:3

Heb. 11:1 provides the following definition of faith: it is the assurance of things hoped for, and the conviction of things not seen. Read Heb. 11:2,6; Eph. 2:8-9; and Rom. 1:17 and discuss what these verses say about how faith relates to a believer's relationship with God.

Hebrews 11 brings attention to the consequences that came from the faith of those mentioned in the chapter. Everyone read through the chapter, and then share which act of faith stands out most to you.

The Bible does not teach about faith as being a one-time event, but rather as an ongoing action. Read Hebrews 12:1-3 and discuss what the passage states about how a person can walk in faith.

Share an experience of when God accomplished something in your life through your faith in Him.

What is difficult about faith?

Take time as a group to pray for each other and encourage each other in walking in faith.
